AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE HAMILTONBAN
TOWNSHIP WELL ORDINANCE 01-2006 SUBSECTION 860

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE
SUPERVISORS OF HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA

NOW THEREFORE, it is enacted and ordained that Well Ordinance 01-2006 is
amended as follows:

Well Ordinance 01-2006, subsection 860

H: Artesian Well - A well in which water rises to the ground surfaces or
overflows the well casing under pressure without the necessity of pumping.

Standard: In the event that an artesian well or any well with artesian potential is
constructed, as addressed in this Ordinance, the well driller, or person responsible for the
well construction, will cap-off such well casing and all pipes/water lines off of the well
casing with water-tight cap(s) or capping(s) immediately upon completion of the drilling
process.

The purpose of this standard is to reduce any possible dropping or lowering of
the static water level within neighboring or surrounding wells, to conserve ground water,
to reduce any possible erosion of soil adjacent to the well or surrounding ground and to
provide for safety and/or health issues, or any of the above which could result in an
artesian well or any other well which has artesian potential.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED, ADOPTED AND ORDAINED into law this ____
day of May, 2008 by Hamiltonban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania.
