HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF ACCEPTABLE TREES THAT MAY BE USED TO FULFILL THE STREET TREE INSTALLATION REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 1004.H OF THE HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors intend to pursue the installation of street trees along both sides of all new streets constructed in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors intend to pursue the installation of street trees along existing street when property is proposed for development or redevelopment; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have adopted provisions within the Hamiltonban Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance that require the installation of such street trees; and

WHEREAS, the Section 1004.H of the Hamiltonban Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance indicates that the Board of Supervisors will identify, by resolution, a list of trees that will be deemed applicable for street tree application in Hamiltonban Township,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the list of trees species in Attachment A that may be used to meet the street tree requirements of Section 1004 of the Hamiltonban Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.


