The following items were discussed:

- The Hamiltonban Township and Valley Quarries, Inc. land exchange became final this morning, December 27, 2007.
- Hamiltonban Township will pay \$250.00 per month for rent to Valley Quarries, Inc. for the use of 3759 Bullfrog Road, Fairfield for up to five years.
- Valley Quarries, Inc. will charge the farmer \$40.00 per acre for the uses of the land.
- Zoning Officer Nicks has responded to questions concerning the proposed Fairfield Shopping Center at Iron Springs Road and Route 116.
- Orrtanna Treatment Plant Usage Surveys are being completed and returned to the Township. Hickory Bridge Restaurant EDU's have changed the most.

- The second lagoon test samples have been sent to the L.A.B. for testing.
- A half payment has been received on one delinquent account.

- A public hearing date will need to be set after the new solicitor is ready to proceed.
- There are some PSATS Trainings scheduled for 2008.
- PMRS appointment date has been set for January 3, 2008.
- The Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission would like to hold a joint meeting to discuss the Greater Orrtanna Investment Group/Old Orchard Farm off Knox Road.
