**Sale of a Sentry Safe to The Fairfield Area Historic Society**


**WHEREAS**, the Second Class Township Code provides for the sale of municipal property under Section 1504 (c) (2) to "a non-profit corporation established for the preservation of historical, architectural or aesthetical sites or artifacts"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fairfield Area Historical Society, Inc. (FAHS) is a public non-profit corporation under IRC Section 501(c)3 and a duly organized corporation under the Laws of the State of Pennsylvania, insuring the historical preservation of artifacts and history of the communities in and around the Fairfield Borough area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township, Adams County owns a Sentry personal safe, Model #S3110, that has never been of usefulness to the Township. The Board also recognizes the said safe would be of a particular benefit to the Fairfield Area Historical Society organization in the accomplishment of their preservation mission; and






