

Resolution Number 2011-04
Hamiltonban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania

To Appoint a Voting Delegate and Alternate Delegate to the Tax Collection Committee

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania appointing a voting delegate and an alternate to represent Hamiltonban Township, Adams County Tax Collection Committee

WHEREAS, Act 32 of 2008, (July 2, 2008, P.L. 197) (hereinafter "Act") mandates the consolidation of the collection of local income taxes; and

WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Act establishes a Tax Collection District ("TCD") in each county; the geographic boundaries of which shall be coterminus with the county in which it is created excepting those municipalities situate within a school district located in more than one district with the greatest share of the school district's population based upon the 2000 Federal Decennial Census; and


WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Act provides that each TCD shall be governed by a Tax Collection Committee ("TCC"); and

WHEREAS, Section 505(b) of the Act requires each political subdivision within a TCD to appoint one voting delegate and one or more alternates to represent the political subdivision of the TCC; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT SO RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township and through the authority of the same that Doreen Premo is hereby appointed as the voting delegate representing Hamiltonban Township on the Adams County TCC and appointing Amy Harbaugh and Robert L. Gordon as alternate and second, respectively on the TCC.


ADOPTED, this resolution this 3rd day of January 2011 at its regularly scheduled meeting which was duly convened in accordance with the law.




