

ORDINANCE NO. 9-90

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL HOUSES AND/OR  
BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN  
HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP TO DISPLAY STREET NUMBERS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. All houses and business establishments within Hamiltonban Township shall have the house number or address of the residence, dwelling, or business establishment displayed on the house, dwelling, business establishment and mailbox. These numbers shall be of contrasting color to the mailbox and to the house, dwelling, or business establishment, and shall be no less than three (3) inches in height. On mailboxes, the number shall be displayed on both sides and on houses, dwellings, and business establishments, the number shall be affixed to the house, dwelling, or business establishment so as to be visible from the roadway. Where a home or business establishment is located more than 300 feet from a roadway, the house, dwelling, or business establishment need not be marked. However, if more than one (1) home, dwelling, or business establishment is located on a common drive all houses and mailboxes for those houses must be marked so as to be visible from the lane or common drive.

SECTION 2. Residents shall have a period of thirty (30) days from the adoption of this Ordinance to comply with the same.

SECTION 3. Upon notification of non-compliance by a member of the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township and/or their authorized representatives,

the notified party shall have fifteen (15) days to comply with this Ordinance. The notification may be written or verbal.

SECTION 4. The Township Secretary or individual issuing building permits for the Township shall inform the person to whom the permit is issued of the requirements of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1. of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) together with the costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo an imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. PROVIDED each day's violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate violation once notice has been given to the party violating the Ordinance by a member of the Board of Supervisors and/or their authorized representative pursuant to Section 2. hereof.
